

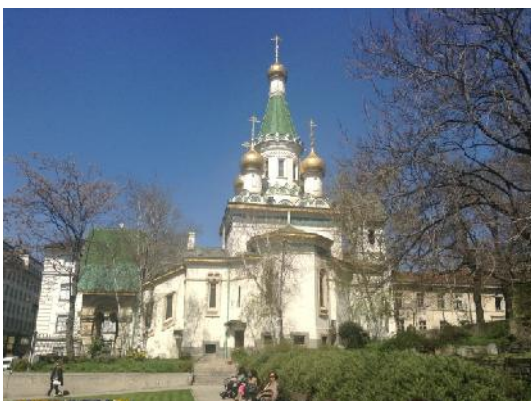
Sofia Diary: Day 3, Wednesday April 17, 2013
